PRODUCT OVERVIEW

A multi-arm timber fingerpost for route junctions, estate entrances and visitor destinations, set out around the sign schedule and approaches.

TYPICAL PRODUCT INFORMATION

ARRANGEMENT	One timber post with two or more directional arms
DIMENSIONS	Post and arm sizes set around wording, viewing distance and site
TIMBER	Oak or another suitable exterior timber as specified
LETTERING	Destinations, directions, symbols and method approved before manufacture
FIXING	Below-ground or surface fixing assessed for the location

MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR

Inspect the post, ground fixing, arm connections, lettering and finish periodically. Individual arms or applied information can often be repaired or replaced without renewing a sound post.

AVAILABLE OPTIONS

- Number, order and direction of arms
- Lettering, symbols and approved artwork
- Post height and arm proportions
- Finish and site identity details
- Individual signs or a coordinated schedule

INFORMATION THAT HELPS US QUOTE

- Destination wording and direction for every arm
- Site plan or photographs showing each approach
- Required symbols, colours or identity details
- Ground conditions and preferred fixing method
- Quantity, delivery and installation requirements
